Background

Master's degree in Architecture / Architectural Conservation, from a reputed/recognized university. Foreign qualification will be preferred

In-depth knowledge of Historic Urban Landscape, Archeology, Building Materials, Conservation Methods and Best Practices, Conservation Charters', Building Construction, Architectural and Cultural Heritage, Museum Studies, will be preferred.

Experience:

- At least 10 years' experience architecture related field with at least 3 years proven work experience in conservation architecture.
